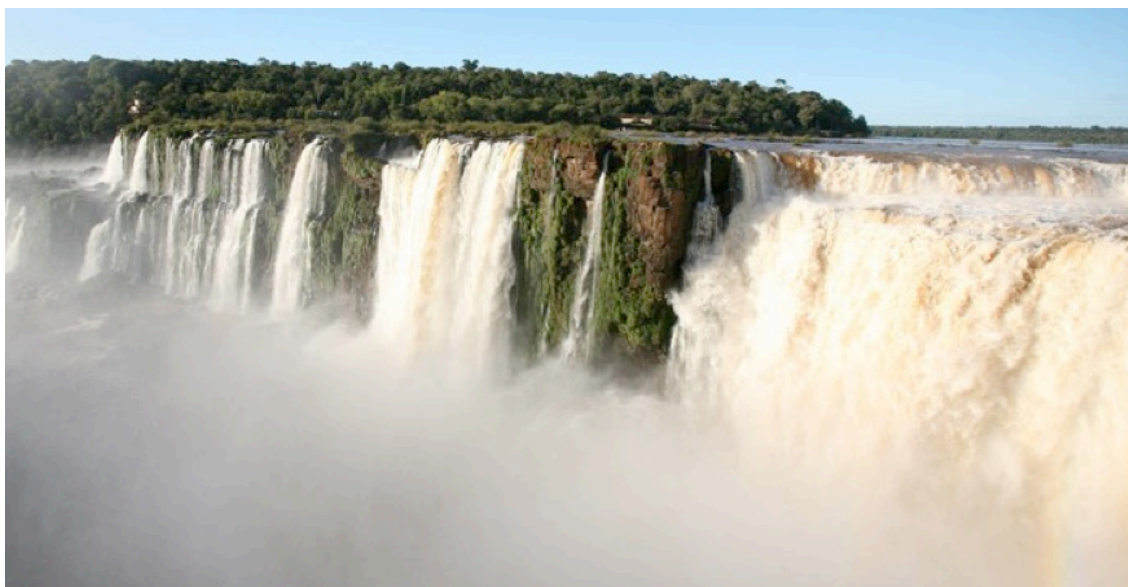


Wine & Waterfalls

Day 1: Arrival in Buenos Aires

On arrival in Buenos Aires you will be met by our English speaking guide and taken to your hotel in a private vehicle.

Overnight at the Hotel Gran Buenos Aires in a standard double room with breakfast included.

Day 2: Buenos Aires

This is a premium shared city tour. Throughout the tour you will enjoy an audiovisual experience prior to each stop, the bus will turn into a micro-cinema and you will see a series of 5-minute video-clips. You will see Evita speaking to the crowd from the Casa Rosada, or the Argentines celebrating the return of democracy. The tour explores the busy centre, including the Plaza de Mayo, where the Casa Rosada Presidential Palace is located; trendy Palermo and the working-class South, such as the famous La Boca and San Telmo districts, heartland of the Tango; and the elegant neighbourhoods of Recoleta & Puerto Madero.

Overnight at the Hotel Gran Buenos Aires in a standard double room with breakfast included.

Day 3: Buenos Aires to Puerto Iguazu

You will be taken to the airport by private car at a prearranged time. On arrival at Iguazu airport our driver will be waiting to take you to the hotel in a shared transfer.

Overnight at the Hotel Jardin de Iguazu in a standard double room with breakfast included.

Day 4: Shared Full Day Tour of the Argentinian side of the Iguazu Falls

We always start the tour early in order to beat the crowds and get the first train to the Devil's Throat, where you can walk along the catwalks over the islands to the most spectacular view of the entire Devil's Gorge, a balcony over the falls. You then have plenty of time to walk the 800 metres of paths on the upper circuit. These new suspended walkways are detached from the jungle surface so as to protect the fauna by preventing disruption of their natural trails. From this circuit you have an upper view of the falls, enjoying their magnificence with a panoramic view. It takes around 1 hour to cover the upper circuit. The lower circuit contains 600 metres of walkways, also detached from the jungle floor, and has great views from below and around the falls. Once you have finished all the circuits, you must go back to the visitor centre where the vehicles are waiting for the transfer to the hotels or the airport.

Overnight at the Hotel Jardin de Iguazu in a standard double room with breakfast included.

Day 5: Iguazu-Mendoza

You will be taken to the airport in our group minibus at a prearranged time. On arrival in Mendoza airport our driver will be waiting to take you to the hotel in central Mendoza.
Overnight at the Bohemia Boutique in a standard room with breakfast included.

Day 6: Shared Standard Wineries Tour with lunch (FD)

You will leave Mendoza City to head for Luján de Cuyo, one of the most developed wine regions in the country. You will visit an olive oil factory and the most well-known wineries, where we will taste great wines. Professional guides will be waiting for us to give a full explanation about the architectural style of the winery, the wine-making process, and how to taste wines. We will visit the Carrodilla Church, which is closely related to the history of Mendoza and its vineyards. Afterwards, we will have an excellent & substantial lunch at a nearby wine cellar.

Notes: 09 to 17hs, on Mondays, Wednesdays and Sundays. Includes lunch with drinks.
Overnight at the Bohemia Boutique in a standard room with breakfast included.

Day 7: Mendoza free day.

A free day to enjoy, or take an optional tour.

Overnight at the Bohemia Boutique in a standard room with breakfast included.

Day 8: Mendoza to Buenos Aires.

You will be taken to the airport by private car at a pre-arranged time. On arrival back in Buenos Aires our driver will be waiting to take you to the hotel.

Overnight at the Hotel Gran Buenos Aires in a standard double room with breakfast included.

Day 9: Buenos Aires

Today you will be taken to the international airport in plenty of time for your flight home.
