- **January to April:** Hammerhead sharks in Rangiroa
 - **April:** Green and hawksbill turtles in Tahiti (no specific season - present year-round)
 - **May:** Manta rays (present year-round in Bora Bora, Rangiroa, and Fakarava)
 - **June to July:** Marbled Grouper Mass Spawning (begins two weeks before full moon)
 - + Shark wall in South Fakarava all year round
 - **August to November:** Whale season in Tahiti and Moorea
 - **November:** Dolphins in Rangiroa (no specific season, present year-round)
 - **December:** Red snappers in Fakarava (spawning from December to January)
